1610A To receive reports, if any, by District/County Councillors or Representatives on other Organisations

Cllr H Crawford reported that she had been on a LALC Course called Playground inspection. This raised some discussion with the committee and it was suggested to use the training on playgrounds and parks around Bourne.

Cllr P Fellows informed members of the classic car and bike show in Bourne on Sunday, although plans had slightly changed due to the weather.

Cllr P Fellows also informed members that after an article in the paper about a Sunday Market, that the notion was just an idea at the Travel and Tourism committee meeting at SKDC. Cllr P Fellows also proposed the literacy festival which is currently held at Deeping to, perhaps, be held around the whole district.

Cllr P Knowles reported on the Dyke Scarecrow festival which is being held on the pub grounds, there will be lots of activities and entertainment, and it is making good steps in the right direction.

Cllr J Kingman reported that the recreation ground is not being cut enough and is getting too long for people to use.

1612A To receive a report on the town's allotments and cemetery

Cllr C Pattison gave a robust report on both the Allotments and the Cemetery. Having undertaken an inspection of the allotments all seems in good shape apart from one Or two plots which the clerk will be writing too.

With regard to the Cemetery the site is still busy not only with interments but also to works Taking place to complete renovations to both the bungalow and the staff quarters.

After having issues with the public toilets at the SK Community Point and the cost of repairing the door mechanisms the clerk suggested leaving them free to use for the public.

Proposed by Cllr C Pattison, seconded by Cllr B Johnson, and unanimously. **RESOLVED: To continue contact with SKDC to reopen the South Street Toilet Block**

1615A To consider the purchase of additional Speed Indicating Devices

This matter had been carried forward from a previous meeting. The clerk informed members that it would be advantageous to purchase a new SID that could be used at various areas in the town. It was generally agreed that this would be a good idea but research needed to be undertaken to assess other SID models.

Proposed by Cllr B Russell, seconded by Cllr B Johnson, and unanimously. **RESOLVED:** For the clerk to carry out the above research into other available devices

1616A To receive a report on the ongoing works at the Town Cemetery

The clerk informed members of the progress of the works in the cemetery and informed members that the budget would need to increase by £5,000 to a total of £45,000

The clerk informed members of the progress of the event, and informed the committee that the hanging baskets are up, and are receiving more sponsors for the planters. He is also working with 'Don't Lose Hope' charity on the project. The judging day will be Wednesday 3rd July.
